There is new breed or ethic group of people being born in Thailand so we believe we should be ready for this group of mixed Thais. Besides, we will have the manpower to do it. Our English Bible students will be able to help in preaching the Gospel to this minority group.

English Bible School

Five of our English students still have their focus on studying Bible in English this February 2018. The school will begin with a study of the Pentateuch which will be taught by Steve Duane Webb. He preached in California, Utah, Missouri, Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, and Tennessee before moving to Thailand. He now resides in Phuket. He married a Thai



Christian, Jannapaporn. Steven has a Master Degree from the University of Illinois and has been preaching for forty years. Both our students and the teacher are well qualified for what they are supposed to do for the Lord in spreading His kingdom in Thailand.
